§3. Significant events

3.1 Particulars about material changes in items of main accounting statement and financial index, and explanations of reasons

Applicable Inapplicable

In the report period, the Company totally completed power generation 1,459 million kw, which increased 55.59% compared with the same period of last year; realized main business incomes RMB 984,946,400, which increased 65.39% compared with the same period of last year; realized net profits RMB 39,226,154.69, which increased 3,890.70% compared with the same period of last year. The main reasons were: (1) the increase of power generation caused increase of power generation incomes; (2) Shennandian (Zhongshan) Electric Power Co., Ltd. and Shennandian (Dongguan) Weimei Electric Power Co., Ltd. gained subsidies of electricity price of the fourth quarter in 2007 and implemented new settlement of electricity price of Guangdong 9E set in the first quarter of 2008; (3) subsidies incomes of fuel increased.

3.2 Analysis and explanation of significant events and their influence and solutions

Applicable Inapplicable

1. In order to cope with the condition of lacking electricity supply in Guangdong caused by climatic disaster, Guangdong Province issued Notice on Increasing Settlement Incomes of 9E Set, decided to encourage 9E set to produce power in peak season and increase incomes of producing power which was not lower than RMB 0.92/kwh (within tax). Hereinto the temporary electricity price of the generators of holding subsidiary of the Company Shennandian (Zhongshan) Electric Power Co., Ltd. and Shennandian (Dongguan) Weimei Electric Power Co., Ltd. increased from RMB 0.457/kwh (within tax) to RMB 0.62/kwh (within tax), the differences of which settled with Guangdong Power Grid Corporation; the differences between RMB 0.92/kwh (within tax) and RMB 0.62/kwh (within tax) were fulfilled by local government. (Detailed information was published on relevant announcement on Feb.5, 2008)

2. According to Notice on Temporarily Collecting Processing Charges of Fuel Gas and Fuel Oil issued by Guangdong People's Government YFH [2008] No.31, the government decided to collected processing charges of fuel gas and fuel oil from all big industrial users in six cities including Dongguan and Zhongshan from Mar.1, 2008 as subsidies of current 9E and 9F gas-steam combined cycling generators. Hereinto the pool purchase electricity price of the generators of holding subsidiary of the Company Shennandian (Zhongshan) Electric Power Co., Ltd. and Shennandian (Dongguan) Weimei Electric Power Co., Ltd. increased to RMB 0.62/kwh (within tax), and gained processing charges of fuel gas and fuel oil RMB 0.30/kwh (without income tax). According to the actual incomes and expenses of fuel gas and fuel oil processing charges and changes of fuel prices, the government would timely adjust charging standard and subsidy standard. (Detailed information was published on relevant announcement on Apr.4, 2008)

3. Disposal development of Nanshan Power's No5, No.6 and No.8 machines

In order to respond to national policy callings of Stopping The Weaker And Starting The Stronger and Energy Saving And Emission Decreasing, according to Guangdong Development and Reform Commission as well as Economy and Commerce Committee's united-issuing documents of Notice on Distribution of Delivering the Plan of Closing Down Small Thermal Power Unit From Energy Bureau of National Development and Reform Commission (YFGN【2005】No.147, and Report on Delivering Implementations of Closing Down Small Thermal Power Unit From Shenzhen Development & Reform Bureau (SFG【2006】No.320), the Company had stopped No.5, No.6 and No.8 machines in Dec. of 2006. In order to activate storage asset, with approval by the 20th meeting of the 4th board of directors' meeting dated on August 19, 2006, the Company entrusted its wholly funded subsidiary Shenzhen Shennandian Gas Engines Engineering Technology Co., Ltd (Shennandian Engineering Company for short) to be responsible for the deposal of Nanshan Power's No5, No.6 and No.8 machines. On Jan. 22, 2008, the Company engaged Shenzhen Xinpeng Asset Appraisal Co., Ltd to make value assessing for its machines. And the principle rating date was on Dec. 31, 2007, and the rating value was in total of RMB 32,016,795. In March of 2008, the Company and Shennandian Engineering Company (the Company's consignee) made Buying and Selling Contract of Shenzhen Nanshan Power's No.5, No.6 and No.8 Machines with Shenzhen Shenye United Trading Co., Ltd to sell No.5/6 machines, No.5/6 heat recovery boilers and No.5 main transformer (rating value is RMB 28,573,856) with RMB 40 million to Shenzhen Shenye United Trading Co., Ltd. On April 15, 2008 the Company and Shennandian Engineering Company (the Company's consignee) made buying and selling Contract with Luoyang Chanhe Bowei Power Machinery Plant to sell No.8 gas machine and accessory system (rating value

is RMB 3,442,939) with RMB 3.44 million.

4. Progress of the work of debt restructure of Zhongshan Power Plant Co., Ltd and Zhongshan Zhongfa Power Co., Ltd

During the report period, according to the proposal agreed in the 7th meeting of the 5th board of directors and the 2nd provisional shareholders' general meeting of 2007 of the Company-Proposal on Debt Restructure, Assets Live and Enterprise Type Switch of Zhongshan Zhongfa Power Co., Ltd and Zhongshan Zhongfa Power Plant Co., Ltd, the Company continues to carry out the work of debt restructure of Zhongshan Power Plant Co., Ltd and Zhongfa Power Co., Ltd.

(1) debt restructure

i. In the report period, the Company assured the debt restructure scheme with Bank of Communications. Until Sep 21st of 2007, Zhongshan Zhongfa Power Co., Ltd (hereinafter referred to as Zhongfa Power) had owned loan with the principal of RMB 55,110,410.00 and interest of RMB 5,736,820.87 to Zhongshan Branch of Bank of Communications; Zhongshan Power Plant Co., Ltd (hereinafter referred to as Zhongshan Power Plant) had owned loan with the principal of RMB 8,601,367.00 and interest of RMB 917,116.07 to Zhongshan Branch of Bank of Communications. The restructure scheme is :

First of all, Zhongfa Power returns the principal for the loan of RMB 55,110,410.00. According to equity share of the shareholders of Zhongfa Power, this account has been collected as borrowings from its shareholders, and then paid back to Zhongshan Branch of Bank of Communications on Dec 28th of 2007.

Then, with the method of Taking Property for Debt, the equipment with estimated value of RMB 8,925,000.00 has been commuted for the principal for the loan of RMB 8,601,367.00 of Zhongshan Power Plant, which brought income of RMB 642.05 ten thousand (these equipment were the ten waste heat boilers of the Waste Heat Utilization Reform Project constructed by Zhongfa Power and the Company which had offered investment amount of RMB 50 million in 2004. With approval from the 7th meeting of the 5th board of directors and the 2nd provisional shareholders' general meeting of 2007 of the Company, the Company terminated technical cooperation in waste heat utilization with Zhongfa Power in February of 2008. Since then, the ownership of the technical equipment for waste heat utilization turned to Zhongfa Power.);

At last, when Zhongshan Branch of Bank of Communications disposed the aforesaid ten waste heat boilers in public, Zhongfa Power and its shareholders assured to join the contest buying with a price not less than RMB 2.23 million. On Dec 28th of 2007, Zhongfa Power provided Zhongshan Branch of Bank of Communications with RMB 2.23 million as the deposit for this contest buying. This capital was collected from its shareholders as borrowings according to the equity share they had. After this operation, Zhongshan Branch of Bank of Communications would derate the loan interest for Zhongshan Power Plant and Zhongfa Power.

ii. With support from Government of Zhongshan Municipal and shareholders from both parties, Zhongshan Power Plant and Zhongfa Power is actively negotiating with Zhongshan Branch of Industry and Commercial Bank of China on issue of debt restructure.

iii. According to the agreements signed between the Company and Zhongshan Xingzhong Group and Zhongshan Power Exploitation Company, after relevant debt has been accomplished with restructure, Zhongshan Power Exploitation Company will derate a debt of RMB 5,926.72 ten thousand of Zhongfa Power. The realization of this income could only be confirmed when Zhongshan Power Exploitation Company implements relevant procedure and offers a formal letter.

(2) Assets disposal

According to the 2nd provisional shareholders' general meeting of 2007 of the Company held on Oct 15th of 2007, Zhongshan Power Plant and Zhongfa Power will dispose the fixed assets, such as sets and equipments, by stages and batches, in public way, such as providing bidding. At present, the Company, together with Zhongshan Xingzhong Group and Zhongshan State-owned Assets

Supervisory and Management Committee, establishes working team with joint efforts, to formally start the disposal work on fixed assets, such as sets and equipments. This work has already received the initial achievement. It is predicted that the returning rate of disposal of sets and equipment and other fixed assets will be higher than the book value of the fixed assets after depreciation, which was recorded in the audit report issued by Lixin Yangcheng CPAs for Zhongfa Power on Sep 25th of 2007. After Zhongshan Power Plant and Zhongfa Power finish the debt restructure and assets disposal, the Company will completely perform its duty to disclose the information concerning to the above event.
